



Chemical Abortion: The Predatory Abortion Industry's New Frontier

Background

The second drug, misoprostol, induces labor, expelling the dead baby from the woman's body.

What are the risks of Chemical Abortion?

Chemical Abortion can lead to heavy vaginal bleeding, severe uterine and stomach cramps, fever, chills, nausea and vomiting, dizziness, immune system inhibition, future fertility issues, infection, and septic shock.
